FINGER PAINTS

Goal: To help your child play and explore through art

Overview: Art play helps children practice creativity, exploration, and self-expression. During this activity, your child will explore with finger paints.

Materials: Paper, finger paints

Directions:

1. Tell your child that you are going to paint together.
2. Allow your child to explore the finger paints and create whatever they want.
While your child is painting, describe what you see them doing. You can say things like, "I see that you are using two fingers to draw two straight lines."
3. When your child is done finger painting, ask them to tell you about their picture.
