Did you know?

Learning to observe the world through the five senses is a foundational science skill. Scientist uses the five senses to make many important observations during experiments.

Materials

WHAT TO DO

1. Using a sentence such as “My mouth tastes something sweet.” Or, “My hands feel something smooth” and ask your child to identify the sense that ties to your statement.
2. Once you have modeled a few times for your child, take turns making observations and guessing.
3. As your child grows confident in their ability to guess, begin using more challenging vocabulary. Introduce words like bitter, gritty, screech, smudged, or fragrant.
